

Syncing iPads

with Apple Configurator





To download apps:

- Login to the computer
- Open **iTunes** from the dock (bottom of screen)
- Choose “iTunes Store” (left hand menu)
- Search for the app in the Search Bar (upper right of iTunes)
- Find the app you want and click the “FREE” button to download
- To check on your download, choose “Apps” under “Library” (left hand menu)
- Close iTunes by choosing “iTunes” from the top menubar and select “Quit iTunes”

Once you're ready to sync apps to your iPads...



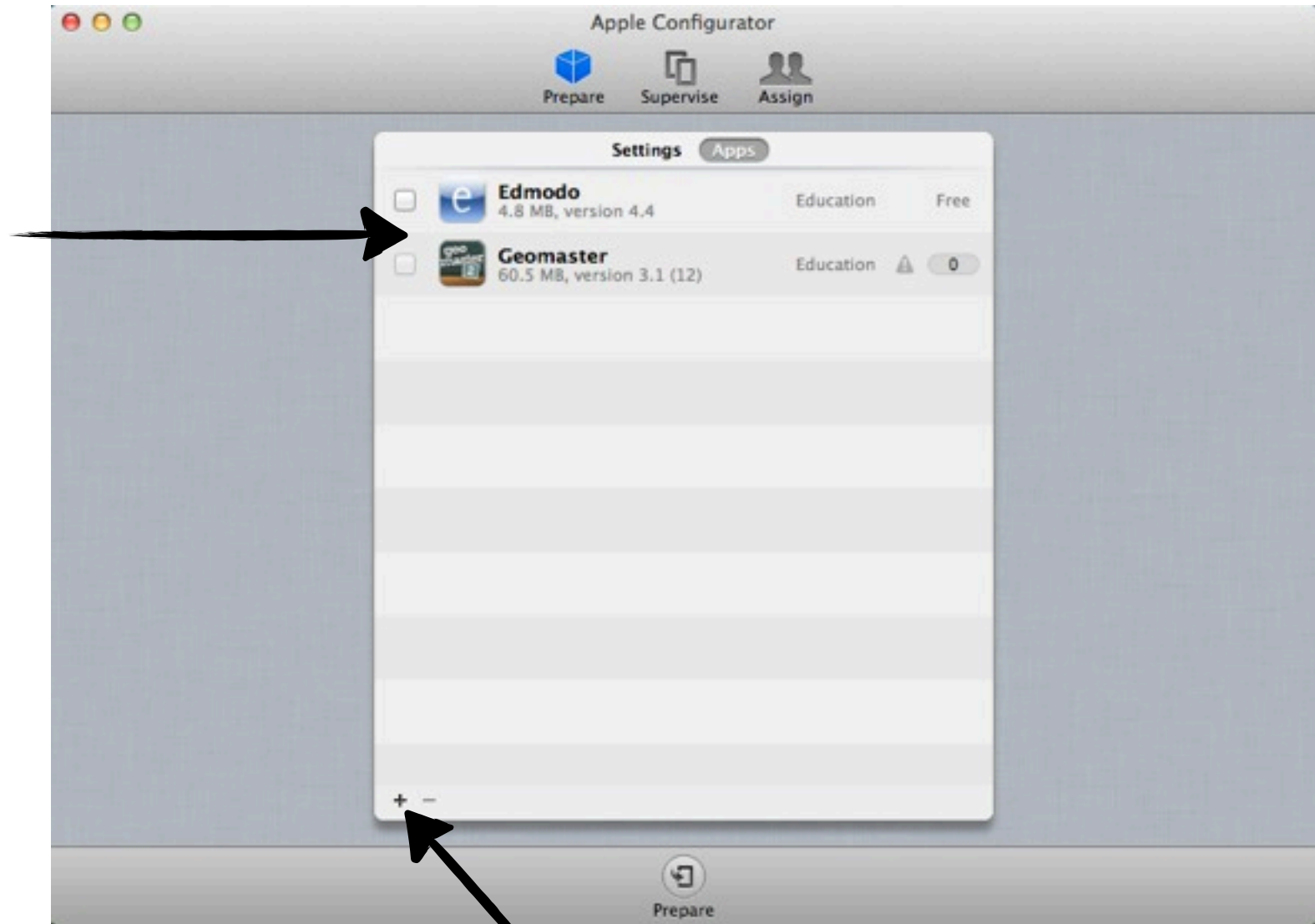
Open

Select **APPS**



Your **SETTINGS** should remain unchanged

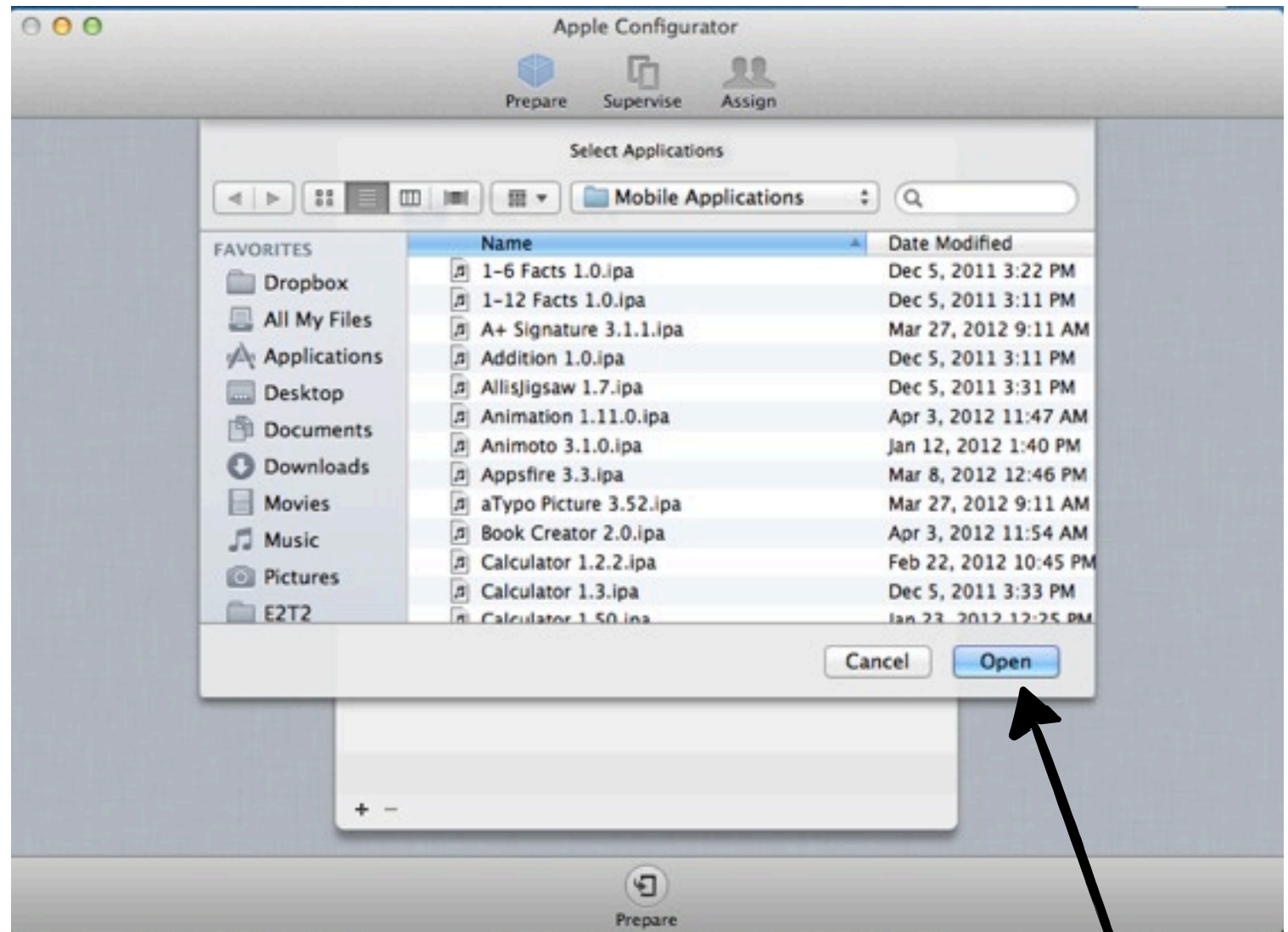
If you have added apps before...
Your previously loaded apps will be listed.



Click the + to add a new app

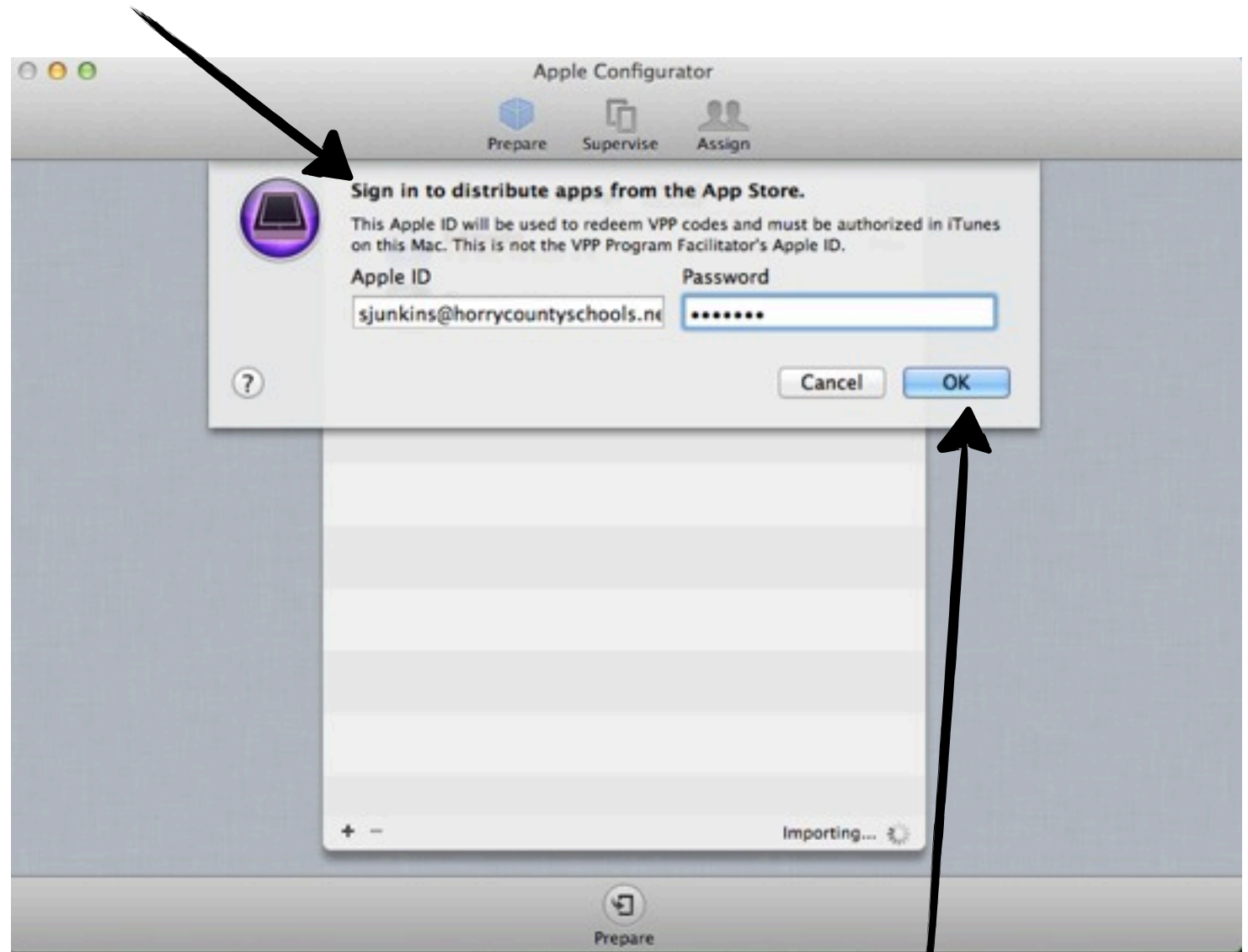
The folder with the app files will appear...

When you are done, click **OPEN**

You may be asked to sign in to your school iTunes account



Click **OK** when finished

sjunkins@horrycountyschools.net

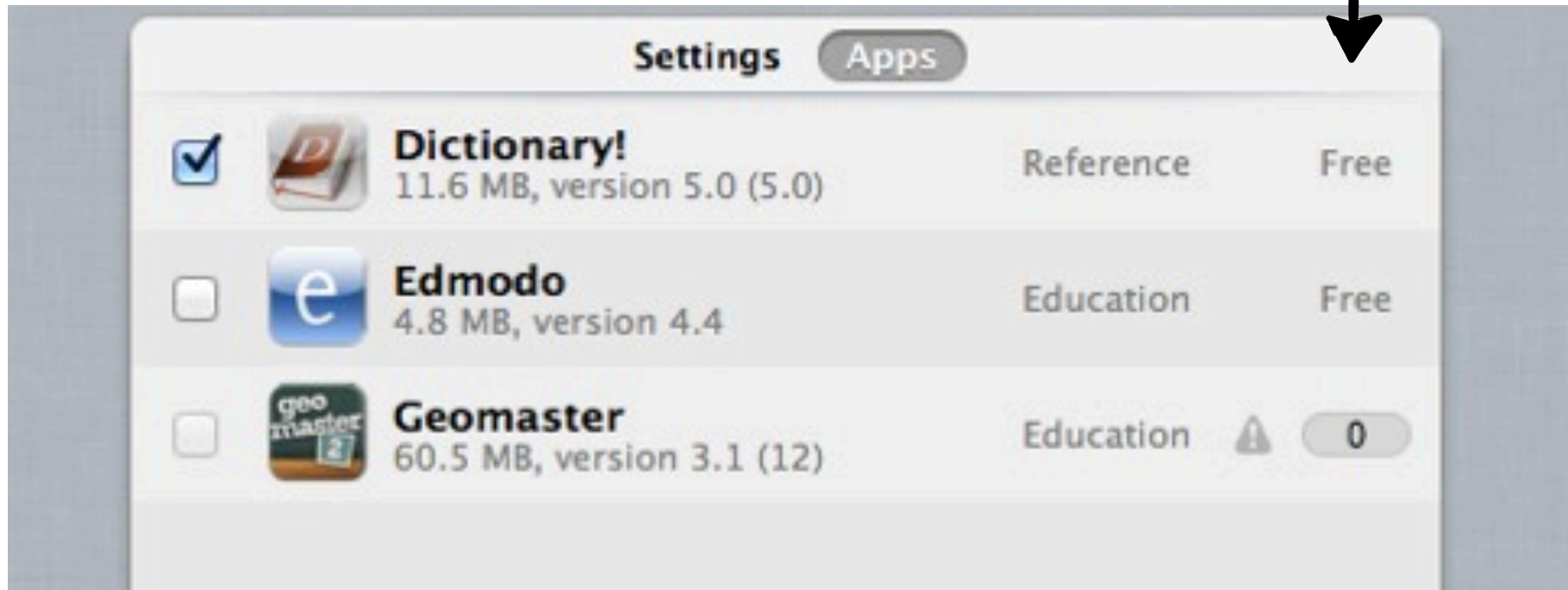
If the password is entered incorrectly multiple times, it could result in the account being disabled for a number of hours

- All passwords include numbers and letters

Free apps will be listed as **FREE**

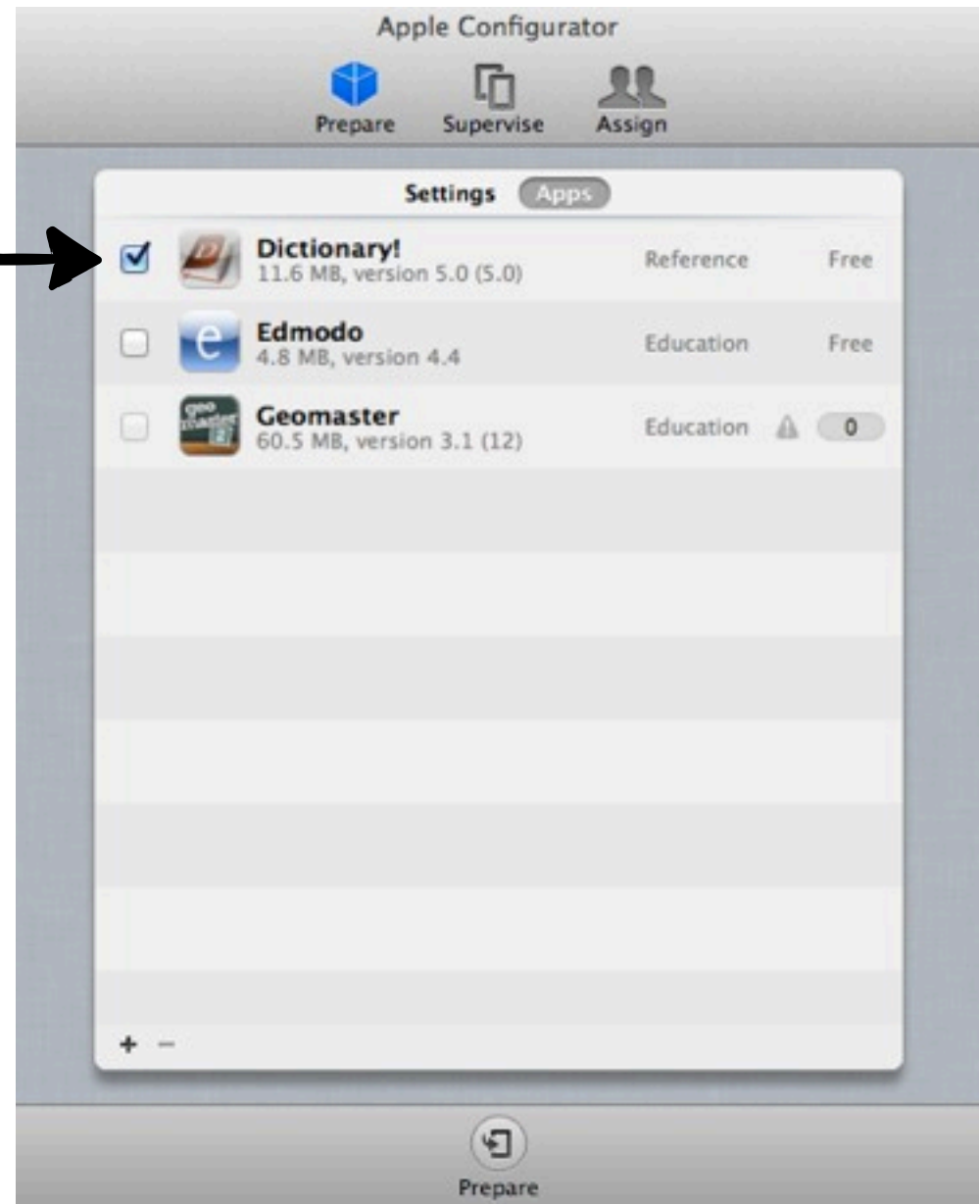
Paid apps require the purchase of licenses



Paid apps will not sync to the iPads unless licenses have been purchased

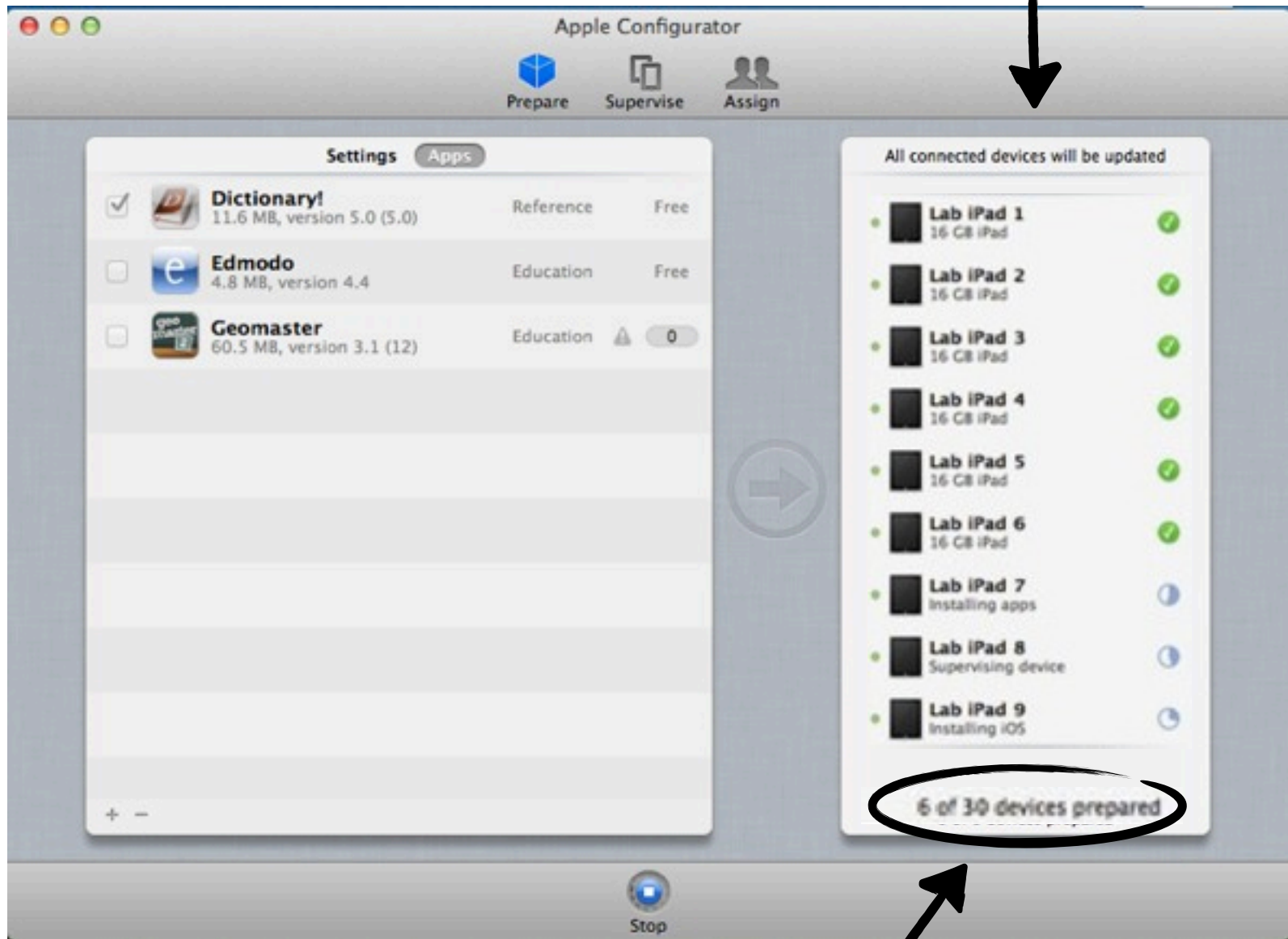
Be sure to **CHECK**
